Neil Rashley is Director of Governmental Affairs and Deputy General Counsel at the South Carolina Department of Commerce. He graduated from the University of South Carolina Honors College in 1984 and received his J.D. from the University of South Carolina School of Law in 1991, where he was a member of the Moot Court Bar and the Craven Moot Court team. From 1999 to 2006 he served as Deputy Secretary of State and General Counsel to the Secretary of State of South Carolina overseeing legal and legislative issues concerning business corporations, Uniform Commercial Code filings, nonprofits and charitable solicitations in South Carolina. He previously served as an assistant solicitor in the Fifth Circuit Solicitor's Office, specializing in white-collar crime prosecution, including computer crime, securities fraud and insurance fraud cases. He presently serves on the board of the South Carolina Administrative and Regulatory Law Association and recently served as a board member of the National Association of State Charity Officials. He worked to draft and pass the Uniform Electronic Transaction Act and the Corporate Code Modernization Act in South Carolina and was involved in designing and implementing South Carolina Business One Stop (SCBOS) – a one-stop shop for electronically registering businesses.
